DID YOU KNOW . . . → North Dakota's 34 Housing Authorities issued 8,052 Vouchers in 2013, paying out approximately \$28,715,000 to area landlords.



Facts About the Oil Boom in Western North Dakota

building communities together

- → The Population is expected to climb 50% over the next 20 years.
- → Over 6 new housing units in Williston are built every day with 2,000 to 3,000 being built every year, but they can't keep up.
- → Rent has increased from \$350 per month for a 2-bedroom apartment to \$2400 per month. → North Dakota Housing Authorities
- →37% of Program Recipients are children.
- → 58% of Program Recipients are elderly or disabled persons.
- → Contrary to Public Perception, only 2% of Public Housing tenants receive welfare payments of any type!
- → North Dakota's Housing Authorities maintain 1,813 units of Public Housing with an average tenant income of approximately \$10,700.
- → Over 535 units of Senior & Workforce

 Tax Credit Projects are owned and managed
 by North Dakota Housing Authorities
 or their non-profit affiliates.



→ The average income of a household using a Housing Voucher is \$12,688.
